Covenant Not To Sue and Waiver of Subrogation: I further agree that I will never sue NE BASSIN Tournament Circuit for damages on account of any injury damage hat I suffer or cause whether known now or which may develop in the future in connection with this or any other NE BASSIN Tournament fishing event. I expressly agree connection with this or any other NE BASSIN Tournament fishing event. I expressly agree to indemnify and hold NE BASSIN Tournament Fishing Circuit harmless from any liability whatsoever, including court cost and attorney's fees arising with respect to such action. Reading and Understanding: I signify by my signature that I have read and understood the above greement and all NE BASSIN Rules.

. Memberships: Memberships into NE BASSIN is \$65 per person. All anglers 16 years of age r younger before their first NE BASSIN event shall be considered a "Youth" and receive embership for \$30. All NE BASSIN fishing events are open to all boat makes, models and motor sizes. Anglers fishing the Elite Series of B.A.S.S or the FLW Tour Events as a boater, during the 2019 season are not eligible to participate in any NE BASSIN Events. The Fournament director and other tournament officials are permitted to fish all of his or her

NE BASSIN division including the regional.

2. NE BASSIN Tournament Fishing Circuit: All entries must be paid in full 5 days before an NE BASSIN Event. Entry fee may be refunded only if the Director is notified no later than 48 hours before the NE BASSIN Tournament. Boat numbers will be picked the morning of the event and will be handed out following our am meeting. NE BASSIN is limited to the first 15-3 eams depending on the state, division and permit. 3. Scoring: Each tournament will have a 100-point scoring system. Sample Scoring 1st place wil

get your team 100 points, 2^{nd} place team 99 points, 3^{nd} place team 98 and so on. All other teams that didn't weigh in any fish will receive 5 points under last place for participating in the event. The team that has the highest final point total in that division will determine the NE BASSIN Division Champions. No Drops are given. 380 points are required to qualify for the NE BASSIN 2-Day regional championship event. A team paying for an event that doesn't fish will receive 5 pts less than last place pts. A team paying for an event that doesn't fish will receive 10 pts less than the last place for that event.

4. Registration: One member of each team is required to be present at the Pre-Tournament Meetings. Failure to appear at the Pre-Tournament Meeting will result in a disqualification not unless the director was contacted before hand and made arrangements that were fair. . Teams that qualify for the regional will need to be a members and in good standing for th ollowing year in order to fish that regional event.

6. Weather Delays and Cancelation: In the event of extreme weather conditions such as Fornados, Tornado Warnings or Lightning, the tournament director along with the officials will monitor the path of the storms and their length, until it has been cleared by these three entities his tournament will be put on hold until warnings expire or the storms have passed, then and only then will we proceed with this tournament. In the event that the storms or warnings have not passed or expired prior to 9 am the director and staff will make the decision to cancel that day of fishing. Should the tournament be delayed due to weather and we decide to launch, the check in times will stand as posted.

7. Take Off: NE BASSIN events will all start between 6:00 am and 7:30am (Eastern Time) nding on the event. Boat take off numbers will be picked the morning of the event.

8. Check-IN: Check-in will be done by 1 flight. There will be a deduction of 1 lb. per minute of your total weight for every minute late to Check-in. Teams more than 10 minutes late to Check-in. n will not be permitted to weigh-in that day's catch. The number paddle you were given at the start of the event must be turned in prior to a team weighing in their fish. No paddle, no weigh in and no more events until the paddle is replaced. If you lose your paddle, a team will have to pay \$50 to replace the paddle as a penalty or else no fish will be weighed in and will receive a 0 for the day with no points given. If a team pays and weighs in, a 1 lb deduction will be deducted rom that teams total weight.

9. Limits: This is a five (5) fish limit per team/angler. Anyone bringing in more than five (5) fish will have their sack culled to the five (5) fish limit starting with the big fish first. Teams ma earry more than five (5) fish but all culling must be done on the water, not on the bank. (State

10. Short Fish Penalties: Only Largemouth, Smallmouth and Spotted Bass may be brought to weigh-in. All fish brought to weigh-in must be at least 12" long. Short fish will be culled from your sack and your largest fish will be culled from the remaining fish. You will be able to ask one" courtesy at each weigh-in/event.

11. Live-well Inspection: Boat must have a working live-well, either built into the boat or portable. Live-wells must have some type of pump or circulator to keep fish alive. All live-wells will be checked before entering the water at all NE BASSIN events.

12. Substitutes: Although Substitutes are not permitted at any NE BASSIN event; we nderstand things come up. If your declared partner cannot fish a regular season event, you are allowed to sub in any friend/family member twice for a given season/division, otherwise will have to fish solo. They will have to pay for a full membership into NE BASSIN at \$65, unless they are a youth at \$30. Substitutes are not permitted with any NE BASSIN 2-Day events. If a rearlong partner serious matter/issue comes up, the NE BASSIN board/director will declare one of the Substitutes if applicable or a new partner should and can be found for the year.

13. Boat and Motor: Boats must have required Coast Guard Safety Equipment and must have motor within the rating limits.

14. Pre-Fishing: All NE BASSIN events will not be closed to pre-fishing. All waters that will be

fished will be closed to pre-fishing from 4pm the day before the start time.

15. Off-Limits: Other off-limits areas will be announced at the pre-tournament meeting

Teams/anglers may not fish closer than 50 yards to another competitor who is fishing unless given permission. If permission is given to one, then all may fish same water. Having a non-contestant sit on a hole for you shall be cause for disqualification. Any team fishing in the offmits areas will have that day's weight disqualified from the tournament.

16. Weigh-in Bags: Participants may only bring fish to the weigh-in station in a weigh-in bag

17. Dead fish Penalty: For each dead fish a 1/2 pound penalty will be deducted from your total weight. A dead fish will not be weighed-in as big fish. Fish that appears altered or mangled shall be the tournament director's decision to weigh or not to weigh the fish.

18. Life Preserver: During any NE Bassin event, contestants not wearing their life jackets zipped and secured when the combustion engine is running and in gear will have that day's weight disqualified from the tournament. Life Jackets can be removed once a team has checked in to the "check in" boat.

19. Ties: Ties for big bass will split big bass pot. Ties for placing in the tournament will be broken by big bass. If still tied, both teams will receive the same points.

20. No Live Bait: Only artificial lures can be used in any NE BASSIN event. The use of pork rind is permitted.

21. No Trolling: Trolling with the use of a combustible engine as a method of fishing is

rohibited.

22. Sportsmanship: All contestants are required to follow high standards of sportsmanship, ourtesy and conservation. Drunkenness/drugs shall be cause for immediate disqualificatio alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs shall be allowed in the boats during the tournament hours extending through the close of the weigh-in. Any ticket will lead to a disqualification.

23. Leaving Your Boat: Competitors shall remain with their partners in the boat at all times during the tournament. Except in the event of sickness or brief excursions for "nature calling" a severe storm or other such hazards. If for any reason a team decides to leave the tournament vaters early, competitors must contact the Director, prior to leaving the tournament. If you have tout trouble, one member must remain with the disabled boat. The other team member may oard another competitor's boat with that days catch and bring fish to the weigh-in. Please ontact the Director prior to doing so.

24. Cheating: Anyone caught cheating in any NE BASSIN event will be immediately banned from fishing any NE BASSIN event in the future. We reserve the right to have a random truth verification test performed at any time. You may not use a cell phone to gain an advantage ove: he rest of the competitors.

25. Protest: All protest must be submitted in writing to the director before the close of weigh-in Verbal protest will not be accepted. The director and the board will meet to discuss any protest nd have a final decision made within 24 hours.

26. State Rules: All state rules and regulations must be followed. Teams breaking a State Rule

or Regulations will have that day's weight disqualified.

27. Insurance: All members will carry 100,000 / 300,000 liability insurance on any boat they might use during any of NE BASSIN Tournaments. Failure to do so or reporting false information will result in disqualification. Participants must have the company name and either policy number or the name of the agent binding the coverage on the membership form.

28. Refusal of Membership/Entry: We reserve the right to refuse membership or entry into a of NE BASSIN Tournament. All Rules and regulations of NE BASSIN Tournaments are

subject to review by NE BASSIN Officials.

29. Awards: 1st, 2nd & 3nd place overall for the year will get team/angler plaques. Lunker team plaques will also be given to the team with the biggest bass for the year, "who fish all team piaques win asso be given to the team with the biggest bass for the year, "who isn an events in that division." The top 1 to 5 teams overall will get a FREE Regional depending on total amount of entries for that division. Top teams per division may have an opportunity to fish for bours money/awards at the regional event. 1st, 2nd, 3rd place teams/biggest fish overall at the regional will get team plaques.

30. Good Standing: A single team must fish or pay a minimum of 4 events to be in good standing per year. If a team doesn't fish at least 4 tournaments for that year, the team will not be in good standing with BE BASSIN and will not be able to fish the following year based upon the lirector's decision. All Teams fishing any division must pay for 3 events upfront with no refund or they will not be able to fish any event.
