If that rod and reel is verified to be the lost outfit that bass may be landed and counted as a legal fish. Anyone guilty snatching or snagging visible fish will have their catch disqualified.  19. Sportsmanship: All contestants are required to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, conservation and honesty. Drunkenness/drugs shall be allowed in the boats during the disqualification.
